How to get there:

By Bus From London Heathrow:

- **Stage1** – London to Oxford - alight at St Aldate's (opposite Christ Church College) where a service then runs to Abingdon
- **Stage 2** – Oxford to Abingdon alight at Stratton Way and The Cosener's House is approximately 5 minute walk from there or taxi's will be available from The Square which is nearby.

Stage 1: Heathrow to Oxford

- Oxford Bus Company runs a service called The Airline.
- Runs every 30 minutes
- Depending on which terminal you arrive at:
 - Terminal 1, 2 & 3 – runs from Heathrow Central Bus Station every hour.
 - Terminal 5 – picks up from outside the terminal.
 - Terminal 4 – A shuttle bus will need to be taken to Terminal 5 where you will be able to get the bus.
- Tickets can be purchased online in advance via their website <https://www.oxfordbus.co.uk/airline-fares> or directly from the driver at time of boarding (card and cash accepted).
 - Tickets purchased in advance are valid for 24 hour either side of the time selected at time of booking.
- Price is:
 - One way - £23 (approx \$27) ... probably better if you are not going straight back to the airport at the end of the Workshop.

- Fixed date return - £30 (approx \$35) if you are sure to return directly to Heathrow once the Workshop concludes

Stage 2: Oxford to Abingdon

- Service is either the X1, X2 or X3 from St Aldate's to Stratton Way (in the centre of Abingdon).
 - Should be one of these services every 10 minutes (ish)
- Tickets are purchased from the driver ... either card or cash
 - £3.70 each (between \$4-\$5)

By Car:

Using the postcode OX14 3JD for satnav / Google Maps.
