

Yasmin Khakoo, MD, FAAN, FAAP is a board-certified pediatric neurologist and neuro-oncologist at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. She cares for children and young adults with primary brain tumors but has an interest and expertise in the prevention and treatment of neurologic complications in young patients receiving treatment for these tumors and other cancers. Her goal is to help preserve neurologic and cognitive function in children with cancer so that once therapy is completed a child can return to their school and family and can resume a normal life. She has had a special interest in paraneoplastic syndromes in children, especially opsoclonus myoclonus ataxia syndrome associated with neuroblastoma since 1993 and has been involved in numerous studies in the treatment of these patients. Dr. Khakoo became the Editor-in-Chief of *Pediatric Neurology* in 2022 and is the recipient of the 2023 Child Neurology Society Arnold P. Gold Humanism in Medicine Award.
